Karine Sargsyan Becomes President of ESBB

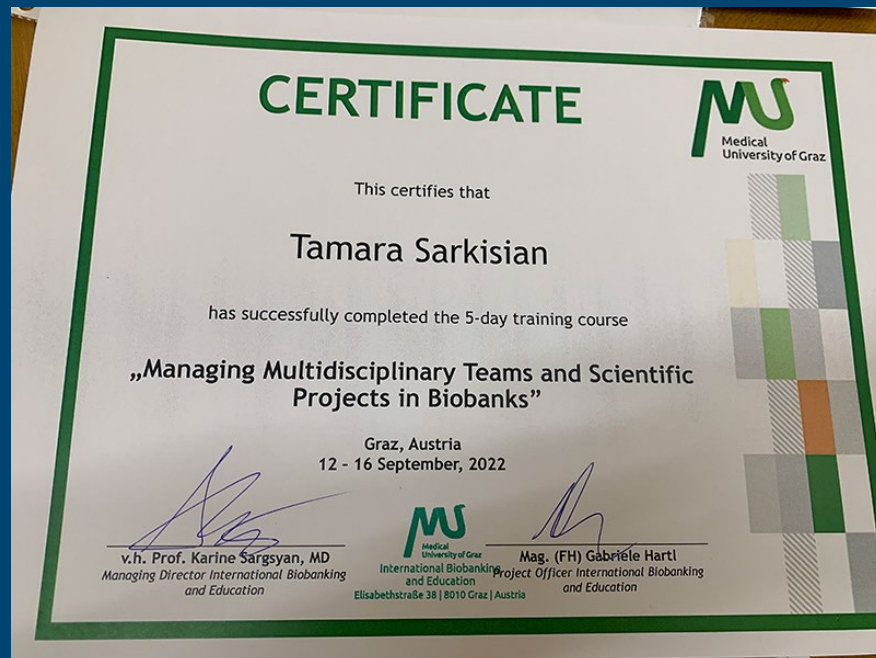
